The map displays the proposed bicycle and pedestrian network for Sherwood, categorized by implementation phase:

- Phase 1 (Green):** Initial routes, including a trail along the western edge and a loop in the south.
- Phase 2 (Yellow):** Intermediate routes, primarily along major corridors like Highway 107 and Highway 87/167.

- Other:** Northwood Middle School, Cold Elementary School, Millers Park, Kiehl Ave, Ritts Recreation Center.

Directional arrows indicate travel paths:

- TO JACKSONVILLE:** Two arrows pointing northeast, one from the northern loop and one from the eastern edge.
- TO NORTH LITTLE ROCK:** Two arrows pointing west, one from the western edge and one from the southern edge.
- BY OTHERS:** A label pointing to a route segment near Millers Park.
