


## Q1 Do you live in Sherwood or own a business in Sherwood?



## Q2 Do you work in Sherwood?



### Q3 How often do you or does someone in your household ride a bicycle for recreation or exercise?



## Q4 How far do you ride for each round trip?



## Q5 Would you or someone in your household ride a bicycle for recreation or exercise, if appropriate infrastructure, such as trails or bicycle lanes, was available?



## Q6 How often do you or does someone in your household ride a bicycle for transportation purposes?



## Q7 How far do you ride for each round trip?







## Q10 How often do you or does someone in your household walk or run for recreation, exercise, or commuting?





**Q12 Would you or someone in your household walk or run for recreation, exercise, or commuting if appropriate infrastructure, such as trails or sidewalks, was available?**



## Q13 What is your bicycling level of comfort?






