Dear Sherwood Residents,

As we welcome 2026, I encourage you to explore the City of Sherwood's Community Calendar, funded by the Advertising and Promotions Commission. It connects you to city contacts, meeting dates, and the many events that make Sherwood a special place to live.

Our motto, "Close to the Action, Far from the Noise," reflects our identity as one of Arkansas's safest and most vibrant cities. With a strong economy, diverse schools, and beautiful neighborhoods,

Sherwood continues to be a place where families and businesses thrive. One of my goals as Mayor has been to strengthen our sense of community, and parks play a major role in that effort. They bring families together and provide spaces where children of all abilities can play side by side.

This year, we transformed a once dilapidated space into one of Sherwood's finest parks. Lake Cherrywood Park features the largest inclusive playground in the city, a treehouse theme that blends into its surroundings, an inclusive basketball court, a fishing lake, a revitalized pavilion, and new bathrooms with water stations. It has quickly become a favorite destination for families.

City Hall Park has also become a community gathering place for daily use and major events. In the summer, residents swim, walk the trails, fish, play pickleball, work out on outdoor equipment, and enjoy the inclusive playground. With beautiful lighting and a safe location, it is accessible at all hours. The park hosted record breaking events this year including Winter Fest, the Easter Egg Hunt, Sherwood's Night to Unite, movies at the pool, fishing derbies, and the Third Thursdays concert series.

Winter Fest, held after the Christmas parade, has quickly become a new tradition. This year included free rides for children, live music, and a drone show synchronized to music. Our July 3 Fireworks and Food Trucks celebration also drew record crowds and delivered the largest fireworks display in Sherwood's history.

We broke ground on Sherwood's first new public buildings in over a decade. A public works, police, and fire training campus will enhance public safety. Private investment is growing with new housing, medical facilities, senior living expansion, new restaurants planned for 2026, and the opening of Sherwood's first major retail store in decades, Aldi.

As we step into 2026, I remain committed to making Sherwood an even better place to live, work, and play. Together, we will continue building a community we are proud to call home.




